Congratulations on completing the All-Hazards Communications Technician (COMT) course sponsored by the Department of Homeland Security Office of Emergency Communications (OEC). The COMT course was developed by practitioners of public safety disciplines from across the country to promote interoperability. To that end, OEC has adopted practitioners' recommendations and now, to be considered a COMT, students of the course must meet all course prerequisites.

Additionally, they must document their experience by completing a Task Book and have the Task Book signed by an authority having jurisdiction – an Incident Commander, a certified COML, or the head of the agency having jurisdiction over the incident or event where the COMT served

A copy of the COMT certificate will be mailed to the State Administrative Agency. OEC recommends students assemble a packet documenting their qualifications, comprised of:

- The COMT class certificate of completion;
- The signed Task Book; and,
- Copies of all prerequisite class certificates of completion.

As States put their certification and credentialing processes in place for the COMTs, students of the classes will then be better prepared to meet their States' requirements.
